I was in Bangkok for two weeks in my new position as the KBR representative for Stryker Brigades and the Army's Pacific Area. I was participating in a planning conference... in South East Asia to be held next spring. I was also traveling all over Thailand ...

Bruce had an R&R planned to see John and I just happened to overlap one night with the two of them (that was enough). It was tough making the 0600 flight out the next morning. Bruce stayed for another two weeks. He went to John's wedding and then they traveled all over the country (see pictures of them at the famous bridge over the river Kwai).

I have an office at Ft Lewis WA which is only a few miles from my home in Gig Harbor WA. My job is to help the Stryker Brigades get ready to deploy to Iraq. There are 7 Brigades now, 3 here at Ft Lewis, one in Hawaii, one in Alaska, one in Pennsylvania and one in Germany. So I travel all over the place in support of training and exercises, and I am eligible to deploy with them when they go to Iraq (Mosul) as each Brigade replaces the one over there.
